Y. **INSPECTION OF RESIDENCE.** The Buyer(s) shall be entitled to a walk-through inspection of the Purchased Lot, which the Seller/Builder strongly recommends Buyer(s) take advantage of, so long as the Buyer(s) request(s) such inspection in writing not more than ten (10) days and not less than five (5) business days prior to the Closing Date; or, as scheduled by Seller/Builder. At such inspection, which shall be scheduled by the Seller/Builder, the Buyer(s) and the Seller/Builder's representatives shall prepare a walk-through inspection report, the form of which is attached hereto as "**ADDENDUM 3,**" entitled, "**CUSTOMER ORIENTATION AND WALK THROUGH CHECKLIST,**" which is to be signed by the Seller/Builder's representatives and the Buyer(s), identifying items or conditions, if any, which the Buyer(s) and the Seller/Builder agree are to be adjusted by the Seller/Builder within a reasonable period of time. Provided, however, that any such adjustments need not necessarily be completed prior to the Close of Escrow and the fact that any such adjustments have not been completed prior to the Close of Escrow shall not entitle the Buyer(s) to extend or otherwise delay the Close of Escrow.
